



Throughout the month of March, CHA is working in partnership with the March of Dimes on a national advocacy campaign, **March for Change**. We are calling on Congress to pass bipartisan legislation that advances health equity and protects moms and babies and to provide increased funding for vital programs supporting them. Specifically, we are urging Congress to support the following:

- S. 2415/ H.R. 3838, the Preventing Maternal Deaths Act, which would strengthen and expand federal support for Maternal Mortality Review Committees;
- S. 1573/ H.R. 3226, the PREEMIE Reauthorization Act, which would continue critical federal research, education and intervention activities to reduce preterm births and infant mortality;
- Increased funding for the Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) in legislation being considered in Congress this week.

Please contact your Members of Congress and ask them to co-sponsor this legislation and support increased funding for maternal and infant health programs.
