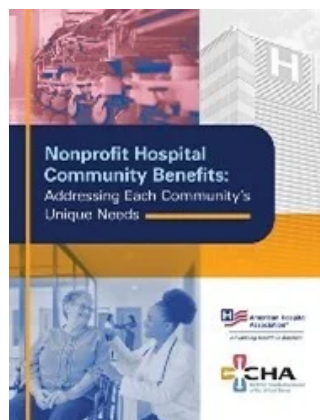

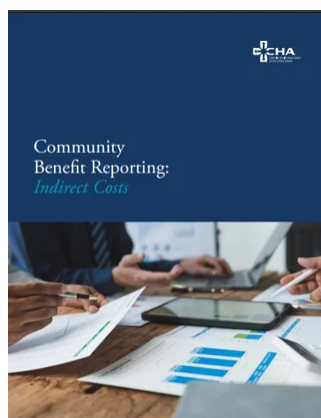


Nonprofit Hospital Community Benefits: Addressing Each Community's Unique Needs
