... taking action before the problem arises in order to avoid it entirely

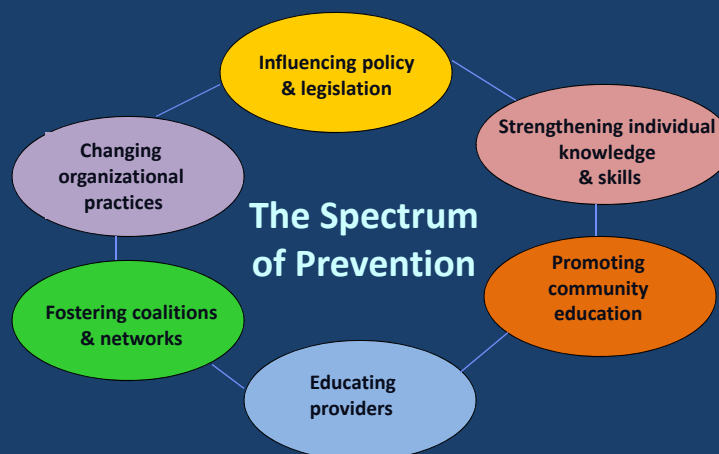
... rather than treating or alleviating its consequences...
