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Chris Dadlez to step down as CEO of Trinity Health Of New England

HARTFORD, Conn. (Aug. 30, 2017) Trinity Health Of New England President and Chief Executive Officer Chris Dadlez announced today that he will step down at the end of 2017.

“This is a decision I have been contemplating for some time now,” said Dadlez. “Together, we have taken this organization far by creating a strong region with a common Mission, and I feel now is the right time to allow a new leader to take Trinity Health Of New England to the next level.”

Trinity Health Of New England Board Chair Kevin J. O’Connor said, “We are grateful to Chris for his leadership in our ministry and our community. His commitment to our Mission and to each person we serve has been steadfast, and his business acumen helped our system grow.”

Dadlez joined Saint Francis *Care* in 2004 and led the 2015 consolidation of the system into the national Trinity Health system. Previously, Dadlez served as CEO of multiple large, complex health systems.

“Chris’s partnership, vision and commitment to people-centered care have served the community well, and we appreciate all he has done in New England. We wish him all the best,” said Trinity Health Executive Vice President Ben Carter.

In a message to Trinity Health Of New England colleagues, Dadlez said, “As I reflect on these 13 years, I am filled with gratitude and humility for all the work that we do to serve our community every day. I am humbled to be associated with the amazing 13,000 colleagues and more than 2,000 physicians who serve and support our Mission every day; trustees from our local boards and our regional board and the thousands of volunteers who dedicate their time and energy to the commitment of our Mission. I thank all of you who have given me the opportunity to provide leadership to our organization.”

In the coming months, Trinity Health will conduct a national search for a new CEO.
