The Rao Outpatient Pavilion Opens Soon!

Amsterdam, New York - Dr. Govind and Mrs. Jyothi Rao recently announced an unprecedented gift of \$1,000,000 in support of the extended provision of high quality outpatient care through "Excellence and Compassion ... The Campaign for St. Mary's Healthcare." The name of the facility, the Rao Outpatient Pavilion, will honor the Rao family for their ongoing and monumental contributions to needed health care in our community.

The Rao's early gift of \$250,000 towards the campaign, prompted other generous donors to commit six-figure support to the "new building" which will be home to the comprehensive Cancer Medicine Center including the new service of radiation oncology, and continuing full-range of services including medical oncology and infusion therapy. The facility will also feature the Women's Breast Health Center, an expanded Medical Imaging Center; Laboratory Services, Outpatient Registration, Pre-Surgical Teaching and Testing; and the site of the new Urgent Care Center. The \$18 million Outpatient Pavilion is set to open in October 2015.

"This extraordinary gesture is affirmation of the great need and value of the new facility, and the incomparable commitment of Dr. and Mrs. Rao and their family, to the health of our community," said Victor Giulianelli, President and CEO of St. Mary's Healthcare. "This gift is one of compassion; a legacy

of their indelible and enduring spirit towards the future of our patients and the culture of care for our community. We thank the Raos for establishing an exceptional philanthropic pace for others."

Dr. Rao has enjoyed a successful tenure in his pediatric practice in Amsterdam, and the Rao extended family includes 8 other pediatricians. The family's generous legacy is underscored by the Neena Rao Charitable Corporation, established to honor Dr. and Mrs. Rao's daughter, Neena, and to help people in need, most notably children. The family's charitable nature has touched countless lives in the city of Amsterdam, throughout Montgomery County, across the country, and in India through the Foundation.

"We are eternally grateful to the Rao family for their support at this critical time in our history," said Al Turo, Vice President for Planning and Development. "The construction of this 40,000 square foot Outpatient Pavilion will lead to increased accessibility and better outcomes without the worry of travel for our patients and their families. We cannot thank the Rao family often enough for their vision and leadership in these times of changing healthcare."
