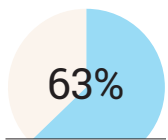

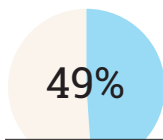

Medicaid makes it possible for children, the elderly, individuals with disabilities, veterans and working families from across the United States to access high-quality, affordable health care services.

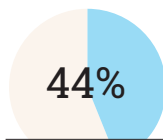

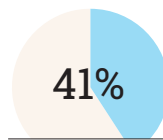
of nursing home residents have Medicaid

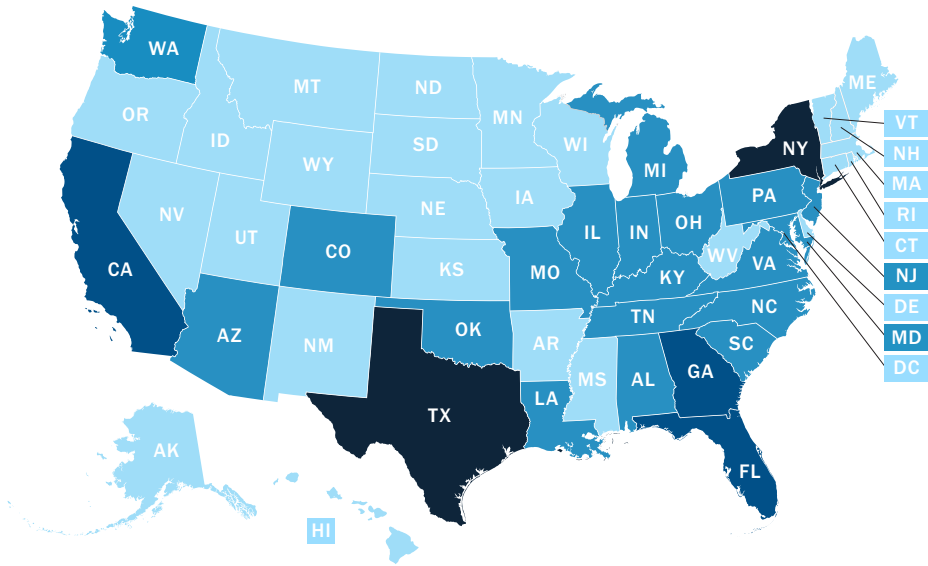
