What is a Faith Community Nurse?

Faith Community Nursing is a specialized practice of professional nursing that focuses on the intentional care of the spirit and the promotion of holistic health within the context of a faith community, such as a church, congregation, parish, synagogue, temple, mosque, or faith-based community agency.

A Faith Community Nurse is a registered nurse with an intentional focus on spiritual health, who primarily uses interventions of education, counseling, prayer, presence, active listening, advocacy, and referral.

Guided by the Scope and Standards of Faith Community Nursing, these nurses serve in communities that are diverse in denomination, size, race and ethnicity.

A faith community nurse collaborates with church leaders and other members of the health ministry. Specific services of the faith community nurse may include:

- Integrator of faith and health
- Health educator and counselor
- Referral advisor
- Community liaison
- Patient advocate
- Coordinator of volunteers and / or facilitator of support groups.

Health Educator

- Facilitates understanding of health and spirituality.
- Trains volunteers to extend health activities to all church members
- Gives group presentations
- Leads wellness activities

Health Counselor

- Offers attention to individuals and families regarding health concerns
- Provides grief support

Advocate

- Helps clients to access the appropriate healthcare and community resources.
- Supports members in positive lifestyle changes.
