

What is a Faith Community Nurse?

Faith Community Nurses (FCNs) are licensed, professional registered nurses (RNs) who practice patient-centered care, combining their nursing knowledge with spiritual care. They advocate for the needs of self, congregants, and the community at large, empowering them to be in control while assisting in finding health and wholeness. Through their roles as health educators and counselors, they promote health and ways to prevent and/or minimize illness.

FCN ministry efforts may be salaried or on an unpaid status. Nevertheless, the RN who accepts the call is caring, compassionate, and a servant-leader with a strong sense of faith and hope. In return, they receive "...the most rewarding job that God has given me. I feel...like I'm fulfilling my purpose, and the reason I became a nurse."

Faith Community Nursing imparts close attention to an individual's spirit, supporting prayer and addressing spiritual needs. Individuals or groups come to the ministry at times feeling hopeless and helpless. The FCN must be able to inspire hope and encourage faith, in turn, changing their outlook and, possibly, health outcomes, maintaining and/or regaining wholeness in body, mind, and spirit.

Foundations of Faith Course Overview



Curriculum

This **Foundations of Faith Community Nursing** course, developed through the Westberg Institute for Faith Community Nursing in consultation with the National League for Nursing (NLN) and the American Nurses Credentialing Center (ANCC), explores this specialty practice which combines professional nursing with health ministry.

Developed from the Judeo-Christian perspective, this curriculum is respectful of, and can be applied to, other faith traditions by exploring their differences and similarities.

In the context of personal faith traditions, areas of discovery include:

- Practice history and philosophy
- Ethical issues
- Healing and the whole person
- Loss, suffering, grief, and more

Participants will utilize the nursing process as it applies to the leadership role of an FCN, preparing them to initiate and maintain this health ministry from within and to the larger surrounding community.



Participation

- Participants **must be registered nurses** with an unencumbered, active license and access to a computer with an internet connection.
- Live online classes meet **Fridays 4:50 - 9:45 PM** and **Saturdays 8:50 AM - 2 PM**
- This 10-class course is conducted with **live participation**.

- **Enrollment** is capped at 15 participants; five participants required to offer course.
