### What Is Faith Community Network?





**Enhance Connectivity**: Link faith communities to the health programs and resources offered by the partnering health system.



Social Needs Assessment and Intervention: Train and support health ministry members to effectively identify and address the social needs affecting their congregation and local community.



**Programs**: Provide programs such as the mental health first aid training and the health minister certificate, enabling them to offer immediate support.

The Certificate learning format is **online** (14 weeks)

Certificate open to those from different faith traditions


Equips congregations, faith community nurses, public health workers, social workers, artists, hospital employees, government workers, and others with foundational language, skills, and knowledge in faith and health; including personal and communal asset mapping skills

The curriculum is **based on national best practices** for health ministry from the Health Ministries Association, a national faith and health organization; the curriculum is reviewed annually and updated.
