Leader:For those who will provide clinical care and support to the woundedALL:Lord, give them the skills and fortitude to work long hours withlimited resources

- Leader:For those who will bury the dead and comfort their loved onesALL:Lord, give them compassion and a heart for mercy
- **Leader:** For those who will organize acts to aide in relief
- ALL: Lord, give them prudence and patience to understand needs
- Leader:For those invited to journey to provide relief services and medical careALL:Lord, give them ease and safety in their travels
